




Tourism Statistics: Before & After GEM Opening

- 2024 15.7 million visitors, \$15.3 billion revenue
- 2025 Projection: 18 million visitors
- GEM: 19,000 daily visitors (first week)
- GEM expected to attract **5 million** visitors annually
- 15,000 daily visitors to GEM
- International visitor spending up 36.1% vs 2019
- name Domestic visitor spending up 31.8% vs 2019



Egypt tourism growth (2019 - 2025)







- En Cairo pipeline: 70 hotels, 17,757 rooms

- International visitor spending projected to reach EGP 1.1TN by 2035




